Ruth also said that we should try to focus on meeting at elementary schools and helping existing programs with their running programs (15 out of 17 schools already have a run club).  • Another idea is to involve high school students for their mentorship abilities.  • Next step is to contact the schools and the people who organize the run clubs to see if they would like assistance with their run clubs and also to let schools know that we will be offering wheelchair heats in the All-Comers' Track meets.  • Ruth also suggested a 4-week pilot this summer, partnering with Chad Campbell of the Boys and Girls Club.  • Ruth also suggested reaching out to other clubs so other sports clubs can be inclusive as well. Ruth will send a needs assessment/letter to ask about interest.  • The board members will reach out to others outside of the board for developing/assisting with the school run clubs.  Grand Prix Sponsorship Team  • To quote Ray: "We did awesome." © The committee obtained 6 sponsors. Kudos to the Grand Prix Committee. Ray brought up the idea of rethinking our sponsorship team to see if we can be more efficient in asking for sponsorships. Perhaps for different levels of sponsorships, we offer different incentives. Cindy pointed out that we keep going back to the same people, but we need to diversify the people we ask. Victoria's is interested in sponsoring the All-Comers' Track Meet, but they might able be interested in becoming a sponsor in general.  • The TerraLoco sponsorship has been nebulous. We need to clarify what our relationship is with Terra Loco as respects sponsorship. TerraLoco donated prizes for the annual meeting and offers a discount to RRC members. Ideas discussed were sandwich boards, yard signs, and flags. Ray and Gwen will look into some signage options. Cindy will make some business cards for us to pass out to runners.</li> <li>Marathon Training Class/10 Mile Training Class for Fall – TC in Motion has provided 5 guaranteed entries to the TC 10 mile for a training class and a promo code for lowest price on marathon for class participants. There would be a Wednesday night run/meeting and the Saturday morning training run from the RAC. Branda, Gwen, and Dale will bring a proposal to the May meeting.</li> </ul>

Hal Martin All-Comers' Track Meets	There are some concerns with proceeding with this since the kids are not yet vaccinated. The board discussed the logistics of spacing/distancing and Covid. We decided to cut down the number of events and increase the time allotted to complete the events. Ruth will review this with Gwen and a new proposal will be sent out electronically. If Dale is OK with the changes, then we will move forward with the proposed plan.
Women's 4-Mile	Gwen has not heard back from the RDs to get the green-light to have the registration go-live.
Reggie Oeltjen Douglas Trail 11 Mile Race	We cannot get approval from the DNR until 60 days out, but we should be fine with our Covid plan. No problems are anticipated.



New Business		
Subcommittee/Volunteer Roles	We talked about the time commitment of the board members on the various teams. We need to look at where our time resources are needed. Many board members are feeling maxed out. Team Leaders: Please estimate how many volunteer hours your team/event requires. This will help us get a feel for how much more we can take on as a board before we overextend ourselves. We want to be sure to consistently deliver quality events. We need to have a larger discussion about what our priorities are. Consider who else can participate/help outside the board.

This is in line with RRC mission and our diversity and inclusion plan. Fundraiser fun run 5/29/2021. Requesting equipment from RRC.  Motion to donate equipment needed for this youth led fundraiser fun run. Rick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.	
Equipment Rental	There has been some inconsistency in the past about equipment rental. We need to establish a policy and some guidance. During the discussion about lending RCI our equipment at no charge, the board felt the treasurer should feel empowered to make such decisions. However, Gwen wisely pointed out that this is what leads to inconsistency because the same person is not always in the treasurer position. Gwen will put together an Equipment Rental Policy and bring to the May meeting.	
Girls on the Run	Given the discussion from Ruth about the school run teams during the Diversity and Inclusion team report, there was agreement that we should focus on where the kids are (not make the kids go to a new location) and on all kids, not just girls. We are going to table Girls on the Run and move our efforts to support school run clubs.	
Litter Bit Better Event	A Sign-Up Genius has been set-up for volunteers to sign up for the Litter Bit Better event on Friday, May 7 <sup>th</sup> at East Silver Lake. "Plogging" as Ray calls it – is picking up litter while jogging. Little Thistle is ready to have a decent-sized group for refreshments following the litter pick-up Ray will provide gloves, 20 trash picker-uppers and garbage bags.	



Rochester Adopt a Park Program	Soldiers Memorial Field and Soldiers Field fence is available for adoption. Gwen moved to adopt Soldiers Memorial Field and Fence. Ray seconded. Motion approved by all.
