Race Director Proposal (Dale, Kasey, Ann, John, Gwen) 10 minutes	 Please review and prepare to discuss the <u>race director proposal</u> Having a race director be an employee (rather than an independent contractor) would give the board more control over the decisions the race director would make. The team recommended going with Smart-HR for payroll. Smart-HR is a local company. They will take care of all payroll 	

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	related withholding and tax reporting. The ledger exports to Quick Books. The Board discussed hiring in this difficult labor environment, the need to share the cost of FICA tax, insurance issues, and fluctuating workload issues. The team will update the Board on RRC tax burden (FICA). The board also discussed that it would be preferable to not hire a race director than to hire a mediocre candidate who was not qualified for the job. The race director proposal team has the job description completed and will do the interviewing. Dale made a motion to approve moving forward with hiring a race director. Ann seconded. The motion is approved with additional clarification re: RRC FICA contribution.

Grand Prix follow up discussion with Steve (Branda - shared by Anna) 5 minutes	 Steve DeBoer felt that Stay Out of the Sun Run would be too much because it would be 3 races in 28 days. We will instead follow up with adding the Good Neighbor Days 2-mile (ask Branda to follow-up).

The board questioned why we were giving their runners a bigger discount than we were receiving for their race, but Cindy felt that \$10 would draw runners in but 10% would not. Concern was expressed that this race conflicts with the Spring Classic 15 Race which is one of our Grand Prix Races. This was supported by the Board.
