

RUNNER OF THE YEAR

- ❖ The Runner of the Year Award (ROY) is awarded to someone who has achieved significant running accomplishment(s) and is also an inspiration in the local running community. It may be awarded to an individual more than once but must be separated by three or more years.
- ❖ RRC membership is not required but the person should be a member of the Rochester area community.
- ❖ Nominations are submitted by Rochester Running Club membership. The RRC Board votes for the winner. In the case of a tied vote, there will be awards given. The award is presented at the annual banquet/business meeting in January.
- ❖ The recipient is not notified ahead of time.
