What do we need to improve?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Race Start Time last-minute changes (!!) - Rochesterfest mile: \$2,000 in donors, \$500+ in funding. Very successful. - Only snafu was day-of registration where people went to start line instead of finish line. they also ran out of forms to register day-of. Had a great turnout. We should list more details on where packet pickup is and where to register day of. Put on the online event and on registration link. We should move up the start time. Maybe 1:00?
